- **1.** The Administrator of Personal Data as Sputnik Photos, registered in Warsaw with postal code 00-891, at ul. Chłodna 20, entered into the Register of Associations of the National Court Register as number 0000254498.
- 2. Personal data will be processed by Sputnik Photos in order to enable logging in to the Archive of Public Protests' website, www.archiwumprotestow.pl, and enable us to keep in touch with users, pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 points b and f of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the Protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (GDPR).
- 3. Personal data will be processed for the period that Users use the Archives and Photographs.
- 4. Personal data will not be transferred to other entities.
- **5.** Each person has the right to access their data and rectify, delete, or limit its processing; the right to transfer it, or object to its processing, and the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of any data processing before withdrawal of the consent. The data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, if they deem that the processing of their personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR. Providing personal information is voluntary.
